NEWS FROM THE OFFICE OF CATECHESIS

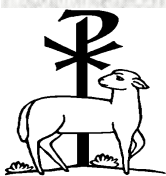


NEXT CLASS OF THE CATECHETICAL INSTITUTE - The diocese has rolled out the last of the basic formation courses, "Christian Prayer & Spirituality." The course will explore eight major "types" of spirituality within the Catholic tradition, as well as opportunities to experience various methods of prayer. The course is six sessions, which will meet bi-weekly beginning, Monday, Jan. 23d, 7-9 pm in the Music Room. If at least five people would like to attend this course on a Tuesday or Thursday morning, please let Jan Carnahan know, as it can be added to the schedule. Cost will be \$25 per person.
