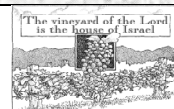

## Changes in the Mass

Fr. T's classes on the upcoming changes in the Mass on Sunday evenings have begun, but you may still start attending -- 6-7:30 pm in THE MUSIC ROOM. ## Safe Environment Training

Please offer to attend at least the initial session with the inquirer to ease any feelings of discomfort. 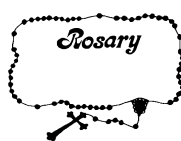
