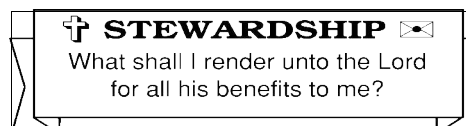

NEWS FROM THE OFFICE OF CATECHESIS



LIVING STATIONS ARE COMING AGAIN! Parishioners are invited to participate in the Stations of the Cross in a special way on FRIDAY, MARCH 26th, 7 pm in the church. The high school youth will present the Stations in live tableaux and lead the prayer reflections and responses. The presentation is a moving experience that enables young and old to truly walk with Christ during his Passion and Resurrection. The nursery will be open for families with children 3 years old and under.

GOOD FRIDAY OUTDOOR STATIONS -- The Middle School Youth will assist the parish in the Good Friday Service, April 2d at 3 pm by reading the meditation at each of the Stations of the Cross. Participants travel with Christ to Calvary by walking the stations, which are located outside at various sites on the church grounds. The service concludes inside the Church with veneration of the cross and reception of holy communion.

REGISTRATION FOR 2010-2011

CATECHETICAL CLASSES will be held after all the Masses on the weekend of March 20/21. The fee will remain the same as it has for the past two years - \$30 per child, with a \$65 cap on families of three children or more. If you plan for your children to attend classes here next year, please register on that weekend as registering early helps the Office of Catechesis know how many catechists have to be recruited and trained BEFORE the start date - Sunday, Sept. 12th. Early registration can also prevent having to put children on a waiting list because a class is closed. We ask the fee be paid at the time of registration.



NEXT CLASS OFFERED BY THE CATECHETICAL INSTITUTE -

Interested adults who would like to learn more about the process of how the Bible was written, how Catholics approach Scripture and how to choose a bible are invited to register for the class, The Catholic Understanding of Scripture. The course will be offered on Monday evenings, 7-9 pm in the music room, and will be facilitated by Jan Carnahan, Director of Catechesis. Cost is \$20 per person, plus \$10 for the required textbook, "The Bible Blueprint: A Catholic's Guide to Understanding and Embracing God's Word."

Diocesan Norms for Fasting and Abstinence during Lent

Fasting, almsgiving, and prayer are the three traditional disciplines of Lent. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence.

Fasting is to be observed by all 18 years of age and older, who have not yet celebrated their 59th birthday. On a fast day one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to each one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed. Abstinence is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed.

Note that when health or ability to work would be seriously affected, Church law does not oblige. When in doubt concerning fast and abstinence, the Parish Priest should be consulted.

Recyclables

It has come to our attention that individuals are placing more than aluminum cans in the Recycle Bin Area outside. We only accept **Aluminum cans**. Please do not place **ANY** plastic bottles or metal cans in the recyclables. The plastic bottles or metal cans may be placed in a separate bag and placed in the green can with yellow lid where the garbage cans are located. Due to the city recycling law, we are taking all items except your trash, in the recycle can. There is one placed in the kitchen airlock in the Church and one out in the Social Hall.
