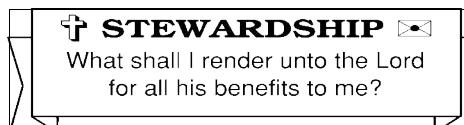

DAYS OF DEEPENING FRIENDSHIP

- A progressive series of reflections on the spiritual life intended to help women "become friends with God." The book used in this study offers anecdotes, scripture readings, written exercises and meditations as catalysts to help women consciously encounter God. Women are invited to access the "Inner Room" where God awaits them, calling them to move through such stages as resistance, attention, engagement and, finally, love.

This laid back "summer retreat" draws heavily upon the meditative tradition of St. Ignatius of Loyola, but with a contemporary approach.
