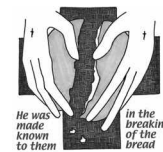

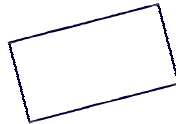
## CONGRATULATIONS TO FIRST COMMUNION CHILDREN and their families!

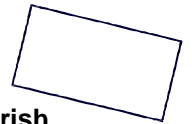

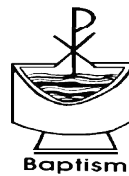

If you have donated food for any of the Parish functions in the past, please check to see if your dish is available in the Church kitchen. Thank you.

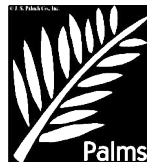
