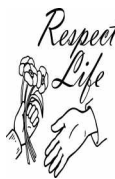

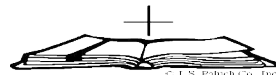
Respect Life News

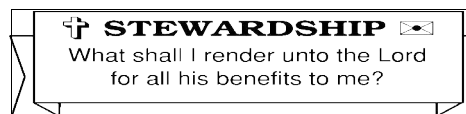
