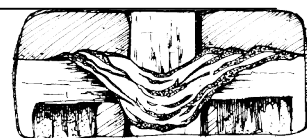

**REGISTRATION FOR CLASSES IN THE FALL** -- Don't put off until later what you can easily do now. You may register your children by going to the parish website - [www.good-shepherd-church.org](http://www.good-shepherd-church.org). The form is located under the "Office of Catechesis link." Early registration will guarantee a spot for all your children AND enable the Office of Catechesis to order the correct number of books for the start of the year. The schedule will remain the same - K-5th Grades will meet Sunday mornings, 9:45-11 am. Pre-school classes for 3 & 4 year olds during the 11:30 am Mass. Grades 6-12 will meet Sunday evening, 6-7:30 pm. Fees are \$30 per child; \$75 for a family of three or more children.

**SUMMER BIBLE EXPERIENCE (SBE)** -- What is there to do when the summer doldrums hit in mid-July? How about SBE! In the cool of the evenings, adults will gather with Fr. T and take a leisurely stroll through the upcoming changes in the translation of the Mass, while children, ages 5-12, will gather in age-appropriate groups to hear inspiring stories of Church heroes and sheroes (saints). There will be fun crafts, games and summer time snacks for everyone to share and create wonderful memories together. Cost? It's free! Date & Time - **6:30-8:30 pm, July 11-15 (Mon.-Fri.)**. **PLANNING TO BE CONFIRMED NEXT YEAR?** -- NOW is the time to register for youth to be registered for Confirmation Class. The process of preparation begins BEFORE the official start of classes with a **Pot Luck on Saturday, Aug. 27th**. Requirements to enter the Confirmation class include good attendance in catechetical classes last year, to be 15 years old and/or a Sophomore in high school, and to have made 1st Reconciliation and 1st Communion. Sponsors for the candidates must be in full communion with the Church, which includes being Confirmed and if married, for the marriage to be recognized by the Church. Need more info? The sessions are designed to answer participants' questions and give information on common misconceptions concerning the Catholic Church. When you hear the acronym RCIA, what do you think? It stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. The RCIA ministry is a process by which non-Catholic adults seek to become Catholic by journeying towards the Initiation Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. A vital part of this ministry is YOU--the community--because you pray for and encourage these adults. One special way you can be involved is to consider being a sponsor: a calling from God to accompany an adult seeking what you already have. It has nothing to do with "worthiness" or "being an expert on Catholicism"; it is ordinary people expressing the extraordinary presence of God in our actions, prayers, life and a willingness to share this faith with another. **WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS TO BE AN RCIA SPONSOR?** Find out at an informational sponsor's meeting on June 26, 2011, 9:45am in room 4 of the Church. ## Etiquette Corner

Thank you for your presence here at Good Shepherd. In order to make our weekly celebrations more conducive to prayer, to preserve the sacredness of our liturgies and to ensure the comfort of all those who are gathered, the following are some gentle reminders of simple church etiquette.

### **Arriving on Time:**

We ask that you make every attempt to be on time (even early) to Mass. Remember to allow yourself enough time for parking and extra time if you need to drop off your children in the nursery.

Due to circumstances out of our control, we understand that there are times tardiness cannot be avoided. If Mass has begun, please enter through the side doors and wait until a break in the Mass to be seated. Remember that it is better to be present, even if late, than it is to be absent from the assembly. An alternative would be to wait until the next Mass.

### **Respect:**

Please remember to show the proper respect for our Lord while in the Church by keeping your voices low. Five minutes before the start of Mass, all are asked to be quiet to allow time for prayer.
