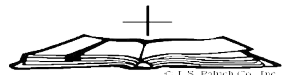

The altar flowers this weekend are given for the greater glory of God and in **loving Memory of Richard Taylor** given by **Frances Taylor**.



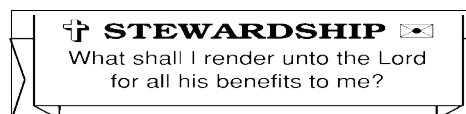

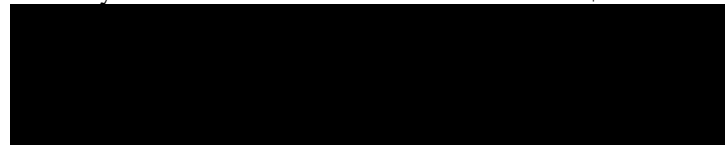

# NEWS FROM THE OFFICE OF CATECHESIS

**How can they believe in him of whom they have not heard?** (Rom 10:14) -- St. Paul in his letter to the Romans asks an important question. If no one will teach or preach about Jesus to the children and youth, how will they ever believe in him?

The ministry of catechesis is part of the primary mission of the parish and all who are baptized are called to support that ministry in some fashion. In his recent statement, "Church Membership and Pastoral Co-Responsibility," Pope Benedict XVI stated, "At the same time, it is necessary to improve pastoral structures in such a way that the co-responsibility of all the members of the People of God in their entirety is gradually promoted, with respect for vocations and for the respective roles of the consecrated and of lay people. This demands a change in mindset, particularly concerning lay people. They must no longer be viewed as 'collaborators' of the clergy but truly recognized as 'co-responsible', for the Church's being and action, thereby fostering the consolidation of a mature and committed laity." In short, the laity is just as responsible to share the Good News of Jesus as the clergy.
