HAVE YOU REGISTERED YOUR CHILDREN FOR CLASSES YET?

There's no time like the present! You can go online to the parish website,

print the registration form and mail or bring it in to the Office of Catechesis. **Parish website - good-shepherd- church.org.** Registration forms are attached to the Office of Catechesis bulletin board in the Gathering Area and are also available from the Office itself during regular office hours. If you would like to serve as a catechist while your child is in class, contact Jan Carnahan, 425-5617. Many parents enjoy spending the time their children are in sessions growing in their own faith by serving as a catechist. CLASSES IN NEED OF CATECHISTS -- In order to provide quality catechesis for the children and youth, the parish requires two catechists per class who have received Safe Environment Training and a minimum of 6 hours of training per year. The following classes need catechists:

Confirmation

CONFIRMATION FOR HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH --

Diocesan policy for Confirmation requires two years of

preparation - a remote year of preparation, which is held in the 9/10th year of high school - and a year of immediate preparation, which follows *immediately* after the year of remote preparation. High School youth in 10th-12th grade **who did not miss more than three classes** in the year of remote preparation will be eligible to register for the Confirmation class. The high school Confirmation class for the 2010-11 year will begin with a "Meet and Greet Pot Luck Supper" on Sunday, Aug. 29, 5-6:30 pm.

CONFIRMATION FOR ADULTS -- Adults who have celebrated Baptism and First Holy Communion, but were never Confirmed will have the opportunity to attend a special Confirmation celebration with Bishop Burbidge next Spring. CATECHIST FORMATION OPPORTUNITIES - In order to provide support for those responding to God's call to serve as a catechist, the parish offers basic level catechist formation, as well as the required Safe Environment Training (SET).
