Evening Session

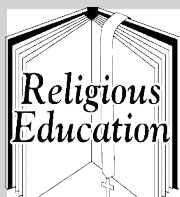
7/8th Grade-B - need one

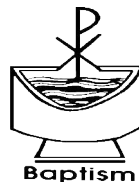
