Marriage: Couples are asked not to set a date for their wedding until an initial meeting with the Pastor.



CHURCH TOUR





Parents, make sure to come to class **this** Sunday to receive the lesson for your children from the Catechists.



Though a simple act, registration is a sign of one's commitment and responsibility to the parish and allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your **Active membership** and is **essential for participation** in parish programs and sacraments.

What is an **Active Membership?** Three points determine active membership:

- Registration in the parish for a sufficient period of time and use of the envelope system in support of the parish;
- Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days;
- Volunteer and participate in Parish activities with time, talent, and treasure as means permit.

Please note: The Facilities and Services of Good Shepherd Church are available to active members.

<u>Sick and Homebound/Hospitalized:</u> Please notify the Parish Office when someone is ill and unable to attend Mass for any significant length of time and would like to receive Holy Communion.

<u>Bulletin Deadline</u>: Requests must be received 10 days <u>prior</u> to the weekend the announcement is to be published. E-mail your request to: <u>gsbulletinedit@gmail.com</u>.

<u>Special Needs:</u> Handicapped accessible doors are located on the left side of the Gathering Area. Wheelchair seating is available in the front row of **chairs**

in the Church. Cars must display a valid handicap sticker or placard to park in the reserved handicap spaces in the Church parking lot.
