

DID YOU KNOW?

St. Methodius (815 - 885) & St. Cyril (826-869).

February 14th is not only a day St. Valentine is remembered for it is also the Feast Day of Saints Cyril and Methodius. These two Byzantine missionaries were brothers and are the patron Saints of Bulgaria.



Saints Cyril and Methodius missionaries to the Slavic peoples in the mid 800's are credited with devising the Glagolitic alphabet. Their translation of Sacred Scripture and the celebration of the liturgy into the vernacular laid the foundation of Christianity in the Slavic areas of Europe. Both brothers are also venerated in the Eastern Orthodox Church.

In 1880, Pope Leo XIII introduced their feast into the calendar of the Roman Catholic Church. In 1980, Pope John Paul II declared them co-patron saints of Europe. together with Benedict of Nursia. They are known as the "Apostles to the Slavs" for their evangelization of the Slavic peoples.

TUITION ASSISTANCE FROM DIOCESE OF RALEIGH

On January 30, 2022, the beginning of Catholic Schools Week, the 2022-2023 application for the African American and Native American Ancestry Tuition Assistance will be available. Catholic school students (K-12th grade) of African American and Native American Ancestry in the Diocese of Raleigh are eligible to apply for tuition assistance.

The assistance awards come from funds granted to the diocese from the Black and Indian Mission Office founded by the Catholic bishops of the United States. All applicants MUST complete a Catholic school enrollment application and a FACTS tuition eligibility application before this application will be considered. Application deadline: March 11, 2022. Decision letters will be mailed to parents no later than May 23, 2022. Tuition awards are sent from the diocese to the applicant's school. Application opens on January 30, 2022, and closes on March 11, 2022. Apply at https://raldioc.configio.com/tuition-assistance.

Sick and Homebound/Hospitalized: Please notify the Parish Office when someone is ill and unable to attend Mass for any significant length of time and would like to receive Holy Communion.

Meet our Pastor, Father Arul

Fr. Arulanantham (Arul) Yagappan, MSFS, was born on May 13, 1970 as the sixth child and the last son of Mr. & Mrs. Yagappan in Trichy, Tamilnadu, India. He wanted to become a missionary, after graduation from



high school, so he joined the religious congregation of the Missionaries of St. Francis De Sales (MSFS) and was ordained to priesthood on January 27, 1997. He obtained a Bachelor Degree of Education from Bundlekhand University, U.P, and a Master of Arts from Osmania University, Hyderabad, India. As a missionary priest he served in different parts of Andrapredesh (A.P) and Tamilnadu as Vice Principal of a school and Director of the Home for the Aged for 10 years in India. In 2005, he was called to serve in the island of St. Lucia, West Indies as a pastor. Then in October 2013, he was called to serve in the Diocese of St. Augustine, Florida assigned to St. Paul Catholic Church. Jacksonville Beach. In March 2016, he became an interim administrator at St. Paul Catholic Church, River Side, Jacksonville. In June 2016 he was assigned as Parochial Vicar at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church. Then he was assigned as Parochial Vicar of St. John the Evangelist parish, Chiefland, Florida until he joined Good Shepherd in Hope Mills in June of 2021.
