
Marriage: Couples are asked not to set a date for their wedding until an initial meeting with the Pastor.



Items needed for KAP (Kids Assistance Program) include: gallon zip-lock freezer bags, tall kitchen garbage bags, plastic spoons, bottled water, single serve boxes of cereal, fruit snacks, individual 100% juice boxes, individual size shelf staple milk, pack of Cheese & Crackers (Please No Peanut Butter), "instant lunch" (in cup) Ramen Noodles w/ vegetables, beef jerky sticks, and Chef Boyardee microwaveable pastas.


