### Retreat into the Passion of Jesus

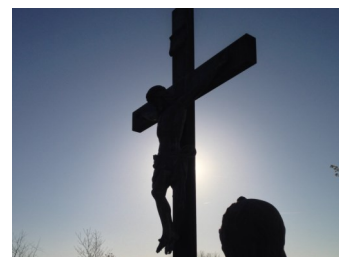
