Baptisms: Planning to have your child baptized? Baptismal Preparation classes are required for Baptisms within the Diocese of Raleigh. Parents need to attend both sessions BEFORE scheduling the baptism of their child. Godparents must attend either at Good Shepherd, or their own parish, which should provide proof of attendance.
