

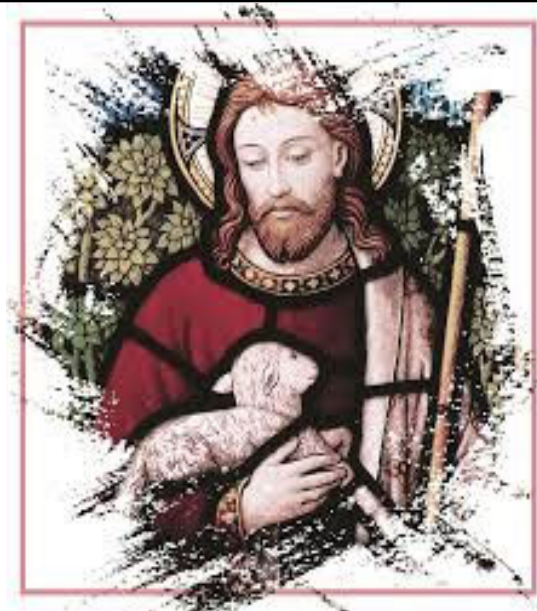

BAPTISM INFORMATION

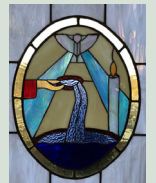
Baptismal Preparation Sessions are held on the first Saturday of each month at 10:45am.

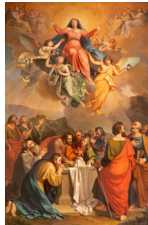

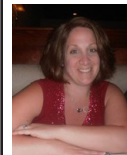

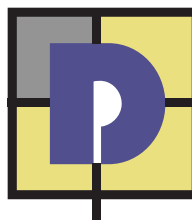
