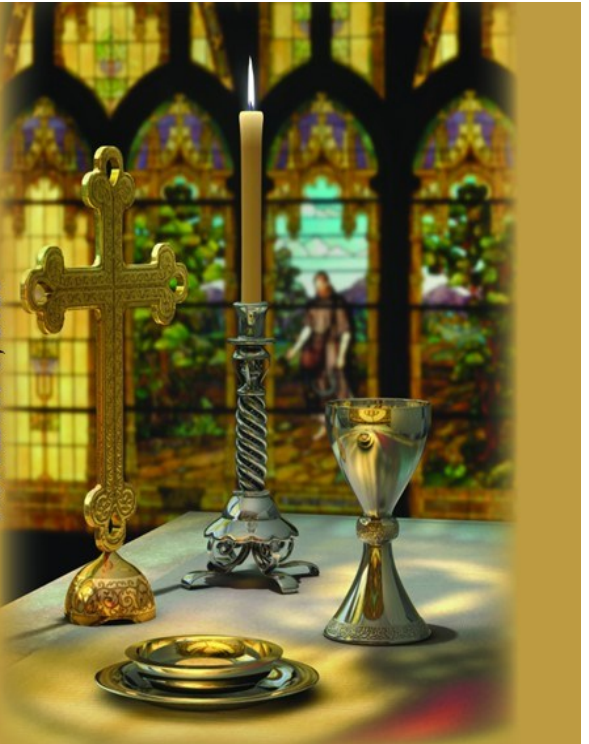
Anointing of the Sick: Call the Parish Office to schedule.

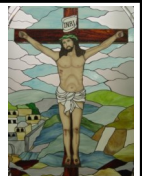

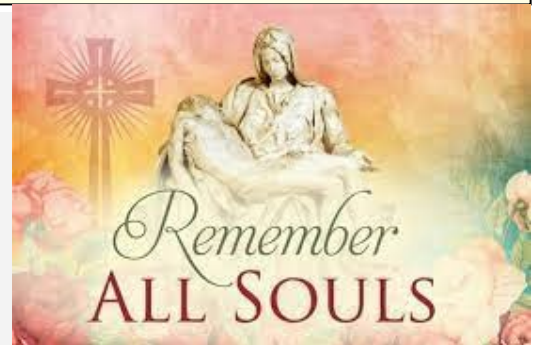
All Souls Novena

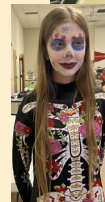

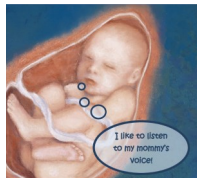


PRO-LIFE MINISTRY Spiritual Adoption

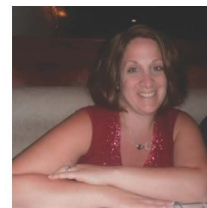

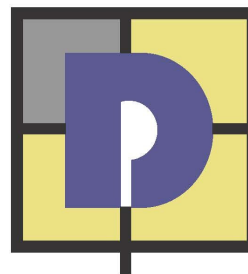
