Our annual Share Tree will go up in the Gathering Area the day after Thanksgiving.



A CHURCH BUILT ON TESTIMONY

"Sisters and Brothers in Christ ~ My name is Don Soucy. My wife, Jeanine, and I have been members of Good Shepherd parish for over 30 years. In that time, we have witnessed the most wonderful examples of



charity and generosity within our parish. Good

Shepherd parishioners, you, me and all those who came before us, truly live up to God's commandment (Love thy neighbor) forming a spiritual family as Jesus instructed us to do. When we arrived at Good Shepherd, we were accepted immediately into the parish family and over time we have witnessed many examples of parishioners giving of their time, talents, and treasures. As in our own families, when one member needs help, the whole family musters and comes to their help.

So, it is with our parish family – Two examples come to mind for me:

- Jeanine and I volunteer for the Care Clinic, which is a Catholic organization in Fayetteville which provides medical and dental services to those without medical insurance. One of its major fundraising events is a yearly golf tournament which requires about 50 volunteers to be successful. Over the last 15 years. about 75% of the volunteers have been Good Shepherd parishioners.
- 2. In the past, for a period of four years the Care Clinic sponsored a free dental clinic for needy people in Cumberland County. Each year the clinic performed dental procedures on over 800 patients over a two day period, changing their lives forever. So, what did parishioners do to help the poor? Over 100 of them volunteered to help by giving their time, or their talents, and/or their treasures.

I am sure that there are many more examples of charity that this parish does, for example supporting Catholic Charities, foreign missions, BAA, fellow parishioners in need, etc. I hope you agree with me that Good Shepherd is the kind of spiritual family that I want to belong to – one that lives by God's law, helps the poor, provides us with spiritual support and a good example for life. As my wife and I have learned in our lifetime, it truly is a blessing to be part of a moral and ethical family. As a member, it is important for each of us to help support our own families as well as our spiritual family with our "time, talents, and treasures". The Good Shepherd parish has earned our respect and support. Thank you" ~ Don Soucy

The Knights of Columbus are accepting donations for Thanksgiving baskets to distribute to needy families in our community.


Items Needed:

It also provides an official record of your **Active membership** and is **essential for participation** in parish programs and sacraments.

What is an **Active Membership?** Three points determine active membership:

- Registration in the parish for a sufficient period of time and use of the envelope system in support of the parish;
- Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days;
- Volunteer and participate in Parish activities with time, talent, and treasure as means permit.
 Please note: The Facilities and Services of Good Shepherd Church are available to active members.

SACRAMENTS

Anointing of the Sick: Call the Parish Office at (910) 425-1590.

Marriage: Couples are asked not to set a date for their wedding until an initial meeting with the Pastor or Deacon. Diocesan requirements mandate a minimum six-month period of preparation.

Baptism: Parental participation in a program to prepare parents is required. Call the Parish Office at least 3 months in advance of your desired baptismal date to make the proper arrangements.

Sick and Homebound/Hospitalized: Please notify the Parish Office when someone is ill and unable to attend Mass for any significant length of time and would like to receive Holy Communion.

Bulletin Deadline: Requests are due by 8am on the Monday prior to the weekend the announcement is to be published. E-mail your request to: gsbulletinedit@gmail.com.

<u>Special Needs:</u> Handicapped accessible doors are located on the left side of the Gathering Area.
