Anointing of the Sick: Call the Parish Office to schedule.


Marriage: Couples are asked not to set a date for their wedding until an initial meeting with the Pastor.

Return to the Distribution of the Precious Blood at Holy Communion

Beginning with the New Liturgical Year (the First Sunday of Advent), we will once again offer Holy Communion under both species (bread and wine).

It is important to note that one does not need to receive Holy Communion under both species to receive the full grace of the sacrament. It is also important to note that each of us must make our own decision when it comes to receiving one or both species.





The Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Since Christ is sacramentally present under each of the species, communion under the species of bread alone makes it possible to receive all the fruit of Eucharistic grace." (CCC, No. 1390)

The reintroduction of this practice in our parish serves as an opportunity to reflect on the gift of the Eucharist, the Real Presence of Christ Himself, to the people of God.



Though a simple act, registration is a sign of one's commitment and responsibility to the parish and allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your Active membership and is essential for participation in parish programs and sacraments.

What is an **Active Membership?** Three points determine active membership:

- Registration in the parish for a sufficient period of time and use of the envelope system in support of the parish;
- Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days;
- Volunteer and participate in Parish activities with time, talent, and treasure as means permit.

Please note: The Facilities and Services of Good Shepherd Church are available to active members.

Sick and Homebound/Hospitalized: Please notify the Parish Office when someone is ill and unable to attend Mass for any significant length of time and would like to receive Holy Communion.

Bulletin Deadline: Requests must be received 10 days prior to the weekend the announcement is to be published. E-mail your request to: **gsbulletinedit@gmail.com**.

Special Needs: Handicapped accessible doors are located on the left side of the Gathering Area.

Wheelchair seating is available in the front row of **chairs** in the Church. Cars must display a valid handicap sticker or placard to park in the reserved handicap spaces in the Church parking lot.


