Anointing of the Sick: Call the Parish Office to schedule.


Marriage: Couples are asked not to set a date for their wedding until an initial meeting with the Pastor.

The Jesse Tree is a tradition that introduces Jesus' ancestors. The Jesse Tree is named for Jesse, the father of King David. Stories from the Old Testament are told, and participants create symbols to hang on Jesus' 'family tree.'

Our Jesse Tree is located to the left side of the Altar near our statue of Mary.

What is a Chrismon Tree? "Chrismon" is a combination of the words "Christ" and "monogram," and means "symbols of Christ." Chrismons are gold and white, representing majesty and purity. You can find our Chrismon Tree in the Gathering Area.

The Jesse Tree symbolizes the anticipation that God's people had for the coming of Christ Emmanuel, "God With Us". The Chrismon Tree symbolizes the fulfillment of God's promise of a Messiah in the birth of Jesus Christ.

We are called to be the bridge between the old and the new– to share God's Good News with the world! Our children, who are also our bridge between our family past and future, decorated these trees!



Good Shepherd's Nativity Scene



Though a simple act, registration is a sign of one's commitment and responsibility to the parish and allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish. It also provides an official record of your Active membership and is essential for participation in parish programs and sacraments.

What is an **Active Membership?** Three points determine active membership:

- Registration in the parish for a sufficient period of time and use of the envelope system in support of the parish;
- Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days;
- Volunteer and participate in Parish activities with time, talent, and treasure as means permit.

Please note: The Facilities and Services of Good Shepherd Church are available to active members.

Sick and Homebound/Hospitalized: Please notify the Parish Office when someone is ill and unable to attend Mass for any significant length of time and would like to receive Holy Communion.
