



Though a simple act, registration is a sign of one's commitment and responsibility to the parish and allows the parish to know how many families live in the parish.

It also provides an official record of your **Active membership** and is **essential for participation** in parish programs and sacraments.

What is an **Active Membership?** Three points determine active membership:

- Registration in the parish for a sufficient period of time and use of the envelope system in support of the parish;
- Faithful attendance at Mass on Sundays and Holy Days;
- Volunteer and participate in Parish activities with time, talent, and treasure as means permit.

Please note: The Facilities and Services of Good Shepherd Church are available to active members.

<u>Sick and Homebound/Hospitalized</u>: Please notify the Parish Office when someone is ill and unable to attend Mass for any significant length of time and would like to receive Holy Communion.



Sacristans

As Bishop Zarama said, "The sacristan provides invaluable help - through the proper preparation of the altar and of the church - so that the miracle of the Eucharist is celebrated in a proper and orderly manner. The sacristan is called to do "hidden" work, to tend to details that may hardly be noticed but are essential. He disappears from the scene and leaves the path wide-open for Jesus in the Eucharist, through the hands and voice of the priest, to be the center and life of the celebration. The sacristan claims no credit...We are called not to show off but, on the contrary, to disappear and allow Jesus to shine and radiate his life - his Love - through our works, through our lives."
