## FROM THE OFFICE OF FAITH FORMATION





and sponsors, and honest reflection. The families of the youth also need your encouragement and your prayers as they strive to pass on the Faith to their children. Some suggestions:

- 1. Dedicate a whole day of prayer and sacrifice for one of the youth & their family by name (listed here >).
- Learn which youth goes with a name on the list & greet him/her at Mass; say you are praying for him/ her & the family.
- 3. Write a note of encouragement to one of the youth & leave it in the mailbox of the Office of Catechesis in the kitchen airlock.
