

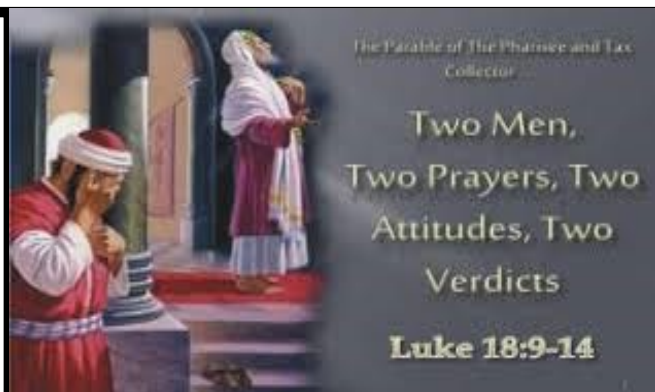

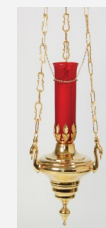
ALTAR FLOWERS

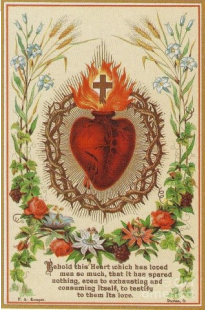

Envelopes are on the Welcome Table. **Please print names legibly** and place the envelope either in the Offertory basket or the basket provided on the Welcome Table. **Please return envelopes by Sunday, October 30th.** All Souls envelopes will be placed on the Altar for the month of November for the Souls of our loved ones. **Mass for the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed will be celebrated on Wednesday, November 2nd at 6:30p.**

Praying for someone by name honors and remembers departed loved ones.

Each and every one of us will be touched by the reality of death in the course of our journey of faith. We have all experienced the painful leave-taking of a loved one in death as we prepare for our own 'going forth' through death to eternal life in Christ. The Catechism teaches: "All who die in God's grace and friendship but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation" (CCC 1030). And so, November is an ideal time to help the Holy Souls through prayer and acts of love and charity and to prayerfully remember all those who have gone before us 'marked by the sign of faith.' Praying for someone by name honors and remembers departed loved ones. St. Pius X remembers them by name in a litany during their Mass of remembrance and places the names in a corresponding worship booklet. Therefore, All Souls' Day and November month is a time to pray for all souls and offer Mass intentions for your loved deceased family members and friends. So, Let us pray for the departed souls in our family and if you wish to offer November Novena Mass intentions, grab the envelope placed at the gathering area in our church and write the names with your generous offering and return the envelope to the parish office before the end of this month.

Note: Your generous donation allows you to share sacrificially in the offering of Mass for your loved ones.

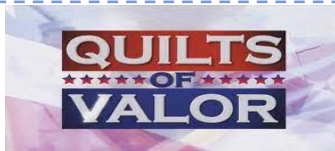

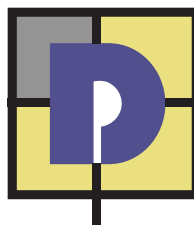
